General Meeting minutes

- 1: **Opening Remarks;** AG welcomed the membership
- 2: **Exit Information;** AG announced the Exit information
- 3: **Division Winner/Sportsmanship Gift;** AG announced that Sportsmanship and Division Winners can organize a Pizza/ Ice Cream Party, submit the receipt and NCHU will reimburse the team up to \$75
- 4: **Volunteer/Coaches Committee;** AG announced that Joe Wetzel will chair the Volunteer Committee and Phil Sweeney will chair the Coaches Committee. AG also announced the each coach should have one team parent assigned to this committee.
- 5: **LIJSL Convention;** AG announce that the LIJSL convention will take place on the weekend of March 7/8 and that NCHU will not have a suite this year.
- 6: **Volunteer Cocktail Party;** AG announced that in lieu of a suite at the convention NCHU will offer another volunteer cocktail party on March 26th 2008 7:30pm - 9:30pm at Nocello's. All coaches and assistant coaches are invited
